Bowlers - Please wear your Flyers T-Shirt or Polo shirts that you have purchased. Otherwise, wear a Purple shirt if possible.

Money – Volleyball athletes who require assistance with their money should give it to their team coaches on Friday morning before leaving for KC. Bowlers Only should give their money to Coach Glenn. It is really helpful if you have your money in an envelope with the athletes name on it. Remember the team pays for all meal and room expenses.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ON SWIMMING AT HOTEL/MOTELS:

Special Olympics Kansas' policy regarding the use of hotel/motel pools:

Motel swimming is not a supervised Special Olympics Kansas activity. Even though teams are traveling to Kansas City for the purpose of participating in the Fall Classic Tournament, only Volleyball and Bowling related activities are covered by SOKS insurance; motel swimming is not. It is necessary to comply with the following policies when swimming in hotel/motel pools.

1. Parents are allowed only to take their own child into the pool area, no other team athlete.
2. Coaches: If you are not a certified lifeguard, you are not allowed to take athletes into the pool area. If the hotel provides a certified lifeguard, then for every four (4) athletes swimming, there must be one (1) coach in the pool at all times.

3. Athletes with history of seizures must have 1on1 supervision at all times.

Anyone found to be breaking these rules will be asked to leave the tournament before it has been completed. Special Olympics Inc. takes this policy seriously and will not tolerate non-compliance. Please do not put my coaching staff or myself in a position to have to ask you to leave the tournament before it has been completed.

IMPORTANT - Please Make Note: Air Capital Flyers Smoking Policy

Smoking and /or chewing tobacco will not be permitted while your team is playing or while you are at the Volleyball or Bowling complex. Keep in mind, we can only police our own team members, therefore, other athletes and volunteers may choose to break this smoking policy.
